

**ORDER GRANTING STAY OF EFFECTIVE DATE OF DECISION**

On December 18, 2015, the Director of Department of Consumer Affairs, Cemetery and Funeral Bureau (Bureau) issued its Ordering Correcting Decision Denying Reinstatement Nunc Pro Tunc in the above-captioned matter. On January 11, 2016, Petitioner Padraic C. Lane and Lane Family Funeral Home filed a request for a stay of the effective date of that decision in order to file a petition for reconsideration.

Pursuant to Section 11521 of the Government Code, the Director hereby GRANTS a stay of the effective date of the Ordering Correcting Decision Denying Reinstatement Nunc Pro Tunc in the above-stated case for thirty (30) days. The purpose of the delay is to allow Petitioner additional time to submit a Petition for Reconsideration.
