TITLE 16. CEMETERY AND FUNERAL BUREAU

Proposed Language

- 1. Amend Section 2310, of Division 23 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations to read as follows:
- § 2310. Regulatory Charge.
- (a) The annual regulatory charge to be paid by every cemetery authority operating a cemetery under the Act is fixed at the sum of fourseven hundred and fifty dollars (\$400750). An additional quarterly charge of eighteleven dollars fifty cents (\$811.50) for each burial, entombment, or inurnment made during the preceding quarter shall be paid to the Bureau. If the cemetery authority performs a burial, entombment, or inurnment, and the cremation or hydrolysis was performed at a crematory or hydrolysis facility located on the grounds of the cemetery and under common ownership with the cemetery authority, the total of all additional charges shall be eight dollars and fifty cents (\$8.50).
- (b) The annual regulatory charge to be paid by every licensed crematory is fixed at the sum of fourseven hundred and fifty dollars (\$400750). An additional quarterly charge of eighteleven dollars and fifty cents (\$811.50) for each cremation made during the preceding quarter shall be paid to the Bureau.
- (c) The annual regulatory charge to be paid by every licensed hydrolysis facility is fixed at the sum of nine hundred dollars (\$900). An additional quarterly charge of eighteleven dollars and fifty cents (\$811.50) for each hydrolysis made during the preceding quarter shall be paid to the bureau.
- (1) Each hydrolysis facility shall submit to the bureau annual maintenance records of the hydrolysis chamber for the preceding year with the annual renewal application. The hydrolysis facility license shall not be renewed without proof of annual maintenance of the hydrolysis chamber.
- (2) Each hydrolysis facility that discharges hydrolysate to a sewer collection system shall submit to the bureau the current Department of Public Health evaluation with the annual renewal application pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 7639.08(e). The hydrolysis facility license shall not be renewed without proof of the evaluation.
- (d) The bureau shall not renew the license of any cemetery authority, crematory or hydrolysis facility that has failed to pay the quarterly regulatory charge prescribed under this section.

- 2. Amend Section 2311, of Division 23 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations to read as follows:
- § 2311. Filing Fee.
- (a) An initial filing fee of fourseven hundred and fifty dollars (\$400750) shall accompany an original application for a certificate of authority to operate a cemetery. In the event the expenses of the bureau's investigation, computed at the rate of (\$100) per day per person, shall exceed this amount, the applicant shall, within five (5) days after request therefore, deposit such additional sums as deemed necessary by the bureau provided that the total sum shall not exceed nine hundred dollars (\$900).
- (b) An initial filing fee of fourseven hundred and fifty dollars (\$400750) shall accompany an original application for a crematory license. In the event the expenses of the bureau's investigation, computed at the rate of one hundred dollars (\$100) per day per person, shall exceed this amount, the applicant shall, within five (5) days after request therefore, deposit such additional sums as deemed necessary by the bureau provided that the total sum shall not exceed nine hundred dollars (\$900).
- (c) An initial filing fee of nine hundred dollars (\$900) shall accompany an original application for a hydrolysis facility.

- 3. Amend Sections 2326 of Division 23 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations
- § 2326. Applications for Cemetery Certificate of Authority and Crematory License.
- (a) Certificate of Authority. Applications for a certificate of authority to operate a cemetery shall be filed on bureau form 23-COA (rev. <u>0</u>1/<u>4623</u>), Application for Certificate of Authority, which is hereby incorporated by reference, at the principal office of the bureau. In addition to the payment of the fees required by section 2311 of these rules, each application shall be accompanied by the following:

4. Amend Sections 2328.1 of Division 23 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations

- § 2328.1. Cemetery Manager and Crematory Manager Application Form, Abandonment, and Review Processing Time.
- (a) An applicant for examination or licensure as a cemetery manager or crematory manager shall complete an application, Form 21A3 (42/1101/23).
- (b) If an applicant for examination or licensure as a cemetery manager or crematory manager fails to take a required examination within twelve (12) months after being notified of eligibility, or fails to apply for licensure within twelve (12) months of being notified of passing the examination, the application or examination result shall be considered to have been abandoned. An application subsequent to the abandonment of a previous application or examination shall be considered a new application and must be accompanied by the required fees.
- (c) The procedure for considering applications for examination and issuance of licenses under this section shall be as follows:
- (1) The Bureau shall inform an applicant for examination or licensure as a cemetery manager or crematory manager, in writing, within fourteen (14) days of receipt whether the application is complete and acceptable for filing or is deficient and what specific information is required to complete the application.
- (2) The Bureau shall make a decision within sixty (60) days after the application is deemed to be completed whether the applicant meets the requirements for licensure or examination. "Completion of an application" means that the applicant has filed a completed application form together with all required information, documentation, and fee.
- (3) The minimum, median and maximum processing times for an application for examination or licensure as a cemetery manager or crematory manager from the date of acceptance and filing of the initial application until the Bureau makes a final decision on the application are:
- (A) Minimum -- seven (7) days.
- (B) Median -- thirty (30) days.
- (C) Maximum -- sixty (60) days.

The cemetery broker original license fee shall be four hundred dollars (\$400).

§ 2313. Cemetery Broker Re-Examination Fee.

The cemetery broker re examination fee shall be one hundred dollars (\$100).

§ 2314. Cemetery Broker License Renewal Fee.

The cemetery broker license renewal fee shall be three hundred dollars (\$300).

§ 2315. Cemetery Broker Multiple Corporate Officer or Partner License Renewal Fee.

Pursuant to Sections 9754 and 9755 of the Business and Professions Code, the cemetery broker renewal license fee for a license issued to a second or additional corporate officer or partner of a partnership shall be one hundred dollars (\$100) for each license in addition to the first fee paid by the corporation or partnership.

§ 2316. Cemetery Broker Branch Office License Fee.

The cemetery broker branch office license fee shall be one hundred dollars (\$100).

§ 2317. Crematory Manager Examination, License, and Renewal Fee.

- (a) The crematory manager examination fee and reexamination fee is four hundred and fifty dollars (\$450.00).
 - (b) The crematory manager license fee is eighty dollars (\$80.00).
- (c) The annual renewal fee for the crematory manager license is eighty dollars (\$80.00).

- § 2317.1. Cemetery Manager Examination, License, and Renewal Fee.

- (c) The annual renewal fee for the cemetery manager license is eighty fifty dollars (\$80.00).

The cemetery salesperson license renewal fee shall be twenty five dollars (\$25).

§ 2321. Change of Name or Address Fee.

The fee for change of name or address on the records of the bureau shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25).

§ 2322. Cemetery Salesperson Transfer Fee.

The fee for transfer of a cemetery salesperson's license upon change of employer shall be twenty five dollars (\$25).

§ 2323. Duplicate License Fee.

The fee for a duplicate license shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25).

§ 2324. Reinstatement Fee.

The fee for reinstatement of a cemetery broker's license or salesperson's license within a fiscal year shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25).



The attached application must be completed to apply for examination and/or licensure as a cemetery manager or crematory manager.

Legislation enacted in 2002 (SB 1952, Stats. 2002, ch. 825 & SB 17, Stats. 2002, ch. 819) requires cemetery and crematory managers to obtain a license in order to act as the responsible manager of a certificate of authority (cemetery), or a crematory.

Any person who has been examined and qualified by the Bureau to act as a cemetery manager or crematory manager prior to January 1, 2003, may, until July 1, 2004, apply for licensure with the Cemetery and Funeral Bureau (Bureau) without being reexamined.

PLEASE NOTE: After July 1, 2004, all applicants must apply for and pass the examination to obtain a cemetery manager or crematory manager license.

CEMETERY MANAGER APPLICANTS:

- An applicant for a cemetery manager license shall be at least 18 years of age, possess a high school diploma or its
 equivalent, shall not have committed acts or crimes constituting grounds for denial of licensure under Business and
 Professions Code (BPC) Section 480, shall demonstrate compliance with any training and experience requirements
 established by the Bureau, and shall be a resident of this state (BPC § 480 and §9723.1(b)).
- A cemetery manager is a person engaged in or conducting, or holding himself or herself out as engaged in those activities involved in, or incidental to, the maintaining, operating, or improving a licensed cemetery, the interring of human remains, and the care, preservation, and embelishment of cemetery property (BPC § 9605.1).
- No person shall engage in or conduct, or hold himself or herself out as engaging in or conducting, the activities of a cemetery manager without holding a valid, unexpired cemetery manager license issued by the Bureau (BPC § 9723.2(a)).
- No licensed cemetery manager shall engage in or conduct, or hold himself or herself out as engaging in or conducting, the
 activities of a cemetery manager without being employed by, or without being a corporate officer of a licensed cemetery.
 You may submit your application to be examined and/or licensed as a cemetery manager, however, you must be an
 employee or corporate officer of a licensed cemetery in order to be designated as the cemetery manager (BPC §
- Cemetery managers must submit a written statement demonstrating two years' cemetery experience prior to being
 designated as a cemetery manager. Please be advised that issuance of a cemetery manager license does not satisfy this
 requirement and this information will be required with the application "Report Designation or Change of Cemetery or
 Crematory Manager; or Request Approval to Share a Cemetery Manager" (Title 16, California Code of Regulations (CCR)

- A crematory manager is a person engaged in or conducting or holding himself or herself out as engaged in those activities involved in, or incidental to, the maintaining, or operating a licensed crematory, and the cremation of human remains (BPC § 9605.2).
- No person shall engage in or conduct, or hold himself or herself out as engaging in or conducting, the activities of a
 crematory manager without holding a valid, unexpired crematory manager license issued by the Bureau (BPC §
 9787.4(a)).
- No licensed crematory manager shall engage in or conduct, or hold himself or herself out as engaging in or conducting, the activities of a crematory manager without being employed by, or without being a sole proprietor, partner, or corporate officer of, a licensed crematory. You may submit your application to be examined and/or licensed as a crematory manager, however, you must be an employee, sole proprietor, partner, or corporate officer of a crematory in order to be designated as the crematory manager (BPC § 9878.4(b)).

The attached application must be completed to apply for examination and/or licensure as a cemetery manager or crematory manager.

Legislation enacted in 2002 (SB 1952, Stats. 2022, ch. 825 & SB 17, Stats. 2002, ch 819) requires cemetery and crematory managers to obtain a license in order to act as the responsible manager of a certificate of authority (cemetery), or a crematory.

Any person who has been examined and qualified by the Bureau to act as a cemetery manager or crematory manager prior to January 1, 2023, may, until July 1, 2004, apply for licensure with the Cemetery and Funeral Bureau (Bureau) without being reexamined.

PLEASE NOTE: After July 1, 2004, all applicants must apply for and pass the examination to obtain a cemetery manager or crematory manager license.

- A cemetery manager is a person engaged in or conducting, or holding himself or herself out as engaged in those activities involved in, or incidental to, the maintaining, operating, or improving a licensed cemetery, the interring of human remains, and the care, preservation, and embellishment of cemetery property (BPC § 9605.1).
- No person shall engage in or conduct, or hold himself or herself out as engaging in or conducting, the activities of a cemetery manager without holding a valid, unexpired cemetery manager license issued by the Bureau (BPC §9723.2(a)).
- No licensed cemetery manager shall engage in or conduct, or hold himself or herself out as engaging in or conducting, the
 activities or a cemetery manager without being employed by, or without being a corporate officer of a licensed cemetery.
 You may submit your application to be examined and/or licensed as a cemetery manager, however, you must be an
 employee or corporate officer of a licensed cemetery in order to be designated as the cemetery manager (BPC §
 9723.2(b)).
- Cemetery manager must submit a written statement demonstrating two years' cemetery experience prior to being
 designated as a cemetery manager. Please be advised that issuance of a cemetery manager license does not satisfy this
 requirement and this information will be required with the application "Report Designation or Change of Cemetery or

- No license crematory manager shall engage in or conduct, or hold himself or herself out as engaging in or conducting, the activities of a crematory manager without being employed by, or without being a sole proprietor, partner, or corporate officer of, a licensed crematory. You may submit your application to be examined and/or licensed as a crematory manager, however, you must be an employee, sole proprietor, partner, or corporate officer of a crematory in order to be designated as the crematory manager (BPC § 9878.4(b)).
