Amend 2334.4(a) to read: (a) The bureau may shall require, after sixty (60) days' notice, that a cemetery authority that has converted its endowment care fund from a net income distribution method to a unitrust distribution method to revert to the net income distribution method for any of the reasons set forth in Section 8726.2(e)(3) of the Health and Safety Code.
